The ideal candidate will also need to function well both independently and in a team environment while providing the best possible care to the patient.

Duties include:

- Review prescription which will specify the types of appliances to be made
- Examine the client's affected area for factors which could affect the fitting of appliances
- Measure, make and correct a patient model
- Design the appliance which will function best in meeting the clients need and fit for comfort, alignment or appearance
- Select appropriate materials and components and give the specification of the device to the technician for fabrication
- Make a device that requires special attention
- Counsel clients on the use of the device
- Provide routine maintenance and repair of devices
- Quality control of all devices before they are dispensed
- Ensure all necessary documentation is submitted for funding acquisition and file management
- Maintain accurate patient records
- Ongoing development of concepts and techniques that improve quality of life for persons requiring orthotic care
- Effective communication and respectful interaction with colleagues and Allied Health Care professionals
- Contributes to health and safety knowledge and ensures such requirements are followed individually and by colleagues (personal protective equipment, safe operation of machinery, etc)
- Identify materials and supplies to be reordered according to inventory policies
